

## FIRE SAFETY WORKSHOP

19<sup>th</sup> – 21<sup>st</sup> of May 2020, at the office of WANO Moscow centre, Russia

Fire Prevention is the subject of significant repeat and generic AFIs across WANO member organisations. Gaps identified in the area of fire protection present a significant risk to nuclear safety, plant integrity and personal safety.

Fire Protection is one of the TOP 4 priorities defined by WANO PC Board for providing support to WANO members in 2020.

WANO Paris centre and WANO Moscow Centre decided to organise this common workshop in 2020.

### Programme

The programme will comprise of presentations from invited speakers on the following topics

- Generic and repeat AFIs and Good Practices on Fire Protection
- The WANO Guideline on Fire protection
- Example of an action plan after a MSM on Fire Protection

**Participants are asked to propose presentation showing their experiences on one of the following subjects:**

- Criteria used for categorisation of the fire events
- Criteria for reporting Fire events to WANO PC
- Current methods and requirements for equipping facilities with first-aid fire-fighting equipment; the principles of choice of fire extinguishers
- On site Fire protection activity using electronic equipment (servers, control panels, data centres, etc.) in the rooms where the presence of workers is constant  
Fire loading Management (permanent and punctual surveillance) and organisation of the Fire protection activities on site; Compensatory measures in case of unavailability of permanent disposal
- Operation experience ( events occurred) during operation or maintenance of the automatic systems for Fire protection; Existing analyses of their effectiveness in ensuring fire safety
- Fire response arrangements, including fire responder training and proficiency

**The proposed presentation should be indicated when registering for the workshop.**

### Break-out sessions

Breakout sessions will be used to create a common vision of the Fire events categorisation, criteria for reporting Fire events and allow time for structured interactions between participants.

### **Objectives of the Workshop**

To share experiences and good practices, amongst WANO members, to achieve excellence in fire protection.

### **Target Group**

Site or Headquarters Fire Protection Senior Managers, from the nuclear industry responsible for Decisions and Leading Activities in Fire Protection Area; Fire Protection Coordinators, Fire Engineers.

The workshop will start on Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> of May at 08:30 and will end at 16:00 on Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> of May.



### **Presentations**
