

EFFECTIVE ROOT CAUSE ANALYSIS

ADDRESSING THE HUMAN AND ORGANISATIONAL FACTORS FOR EFFECTIVE RESOLVING CORRECTIVE ACTIONS

25th – 27st October 2022, Borssele, The Netherlands

The Workshop is organised by WANO Paris Centre in collaboration with Borssele NPP.

Background

Root cause analysis (RCA) is a systematic process to identify “root causes” of events and to address them. This covers technical, organization and behavioral causes. The in-depth and correct identification of these aspects is key to ensure management effectiveness.

The experience from WANO missions showed that the Human and Organizational Factors (HOF) are insufficiently taken into account in the RCA. Ignorance of ‘human factors’, not questioning the reason for the Human behaviors, and missing experience in interview technique has resulted in incomplete RCA. HOF is not systematically integrated in the Safety Management System contributing to unspecific and delayed investigation. It is late visible that improvement measures are neither effective nor sustainable. This increase the risk that failures occur again. After that, the analysis starts again and contribute to ineffective management of the organization.

Objectives

The main objective of this work shop is to deliver the participants knowledge and confidence to apply the required depth of attention related to HOF in the RCA. It should give an understanding how to perform the interviews and how the integration of HOF in the Safety Management System can facilitate the investigation. The workshop will share experience also from other industries and deliver proposals to enhance solutions effectiveness.

Topics

The workshop focuses on HOF when performing a RCA, the integration of HOF in the safety management system and the effective implementation of solutions. It covers the following:

- The basic tools: How do you choose the right tools to analyse the appropriate events (screening, event causal factor charts, 5 Whys etc.)?
- Investigation in depth for HOF: How do you decide if the RCA is complete and deep enough? Do you ask useful questions and methods?
- Manager effectiveness: How do you define, select and implement the most important actions to ensure that the HOF aspects are addressed?
- Effectiveness of actions: How do you prove if actions are effective and sustainable to avoid repetition?

Target group

The workshop is open for all WANO PC members who want to effectively use the RCA to continuously improve their organisation. It is aimed at all persons who use the method, want to improve the analysis of HOF, and for those who are responsible for the implementation of continuous improvement solutions at the organisation following the RCA.

Through sharing information, WANO and member presentations, each delegate is asked to take away improvements to adapt and implement at the own station.

Participants will be invited to share their experience in on this topic.

Pandemic precautions
