Fire Safety workshop

21st – 23rd of November 2023, Hosted by Almaraz NPP, Spain

Fire Protection is the subject of significant repeat and generic AFIs across WANO member organisations. Gaps identified in the area of fire protection present a significant risk to nuclear safety, plant integrity and personal safety.

Fire Protection is one of the priorities defined by WANO for providing support to WANO members.

Objective of the Workshop

To share experiences and good practices amongst WANO members, to achieve excellence in fire protection.

Topics

The programme will comprise of presentations to cover the following topics:

- Calorific Value Assessments – Templates and intelligent electronic assessment platforms
- Fire Safety Risk Assessments for Life and Nuclear Safety – How Plants combine the two to ensure a weighted result
- Hot Works Assessment Process and how this has reduced fires on Plant
- Fire Safety System Health Reports (System Engineers reports on the health of Active Fire Protection Assets) – How Stations keep abreast of the Active Fire Protection Assets
- Station Fire Safety Dashboards – How visible is Fire Safety on your Station? What does it tell people?
- Station Staff Fire Safety Awareness training requirements – How do you meet your Countries Fire Safety Regulations? Theory, practical fire extinguisher training, advanced theory training for other personnel such as Building Managers, Duty Authorised Persons and Duty Holders

- Fire Alarm Response electronic database – What is your Stations process for responding to a fire alarm and what information is available to the Control Room Operators (visual management)
- Three Fire Safety Issues that you have taken from inadequate to adequate and/or best in class

Presentations from the participants

For the best learning from each other, it would be very beneficial for all the participants to have volunteer delegates describing an event that they have had, and especially how they resolved it and what the wider learning was. It doesn't need to be a big event and may only take 10 minutes to feedback how they have improved from an event.

Break-out sessions

Breakout sessions will be used to allow time for structured interactions in practical situations.

Target group

Site Fire Protection Senior Managers, from the nuclear industry responsible for Decisions and Leading Activities in Fire Protection Area.

The workshop will be mentored by an Industrial Representative in Senior Management position, in order to provide references, support, understanding, insights and vision.

An invited speaker from the London Fire Brigade (one of the largest Fire Brigades in the World) will take part in the workshop with a specific presentation and during the discussions.

Arrival and Departure

Participants should arrive at the hotel on the 20th of November. The workshop will start at 08:30 on 21st and will end at 17:00 on 22nd of November. An optional visit of the Almaraz NPP will be proposed for the volunteers on 23rd in the morning, till 13:00 local time.

A get together diner offered by WANO PC will be organised on 21st of November.

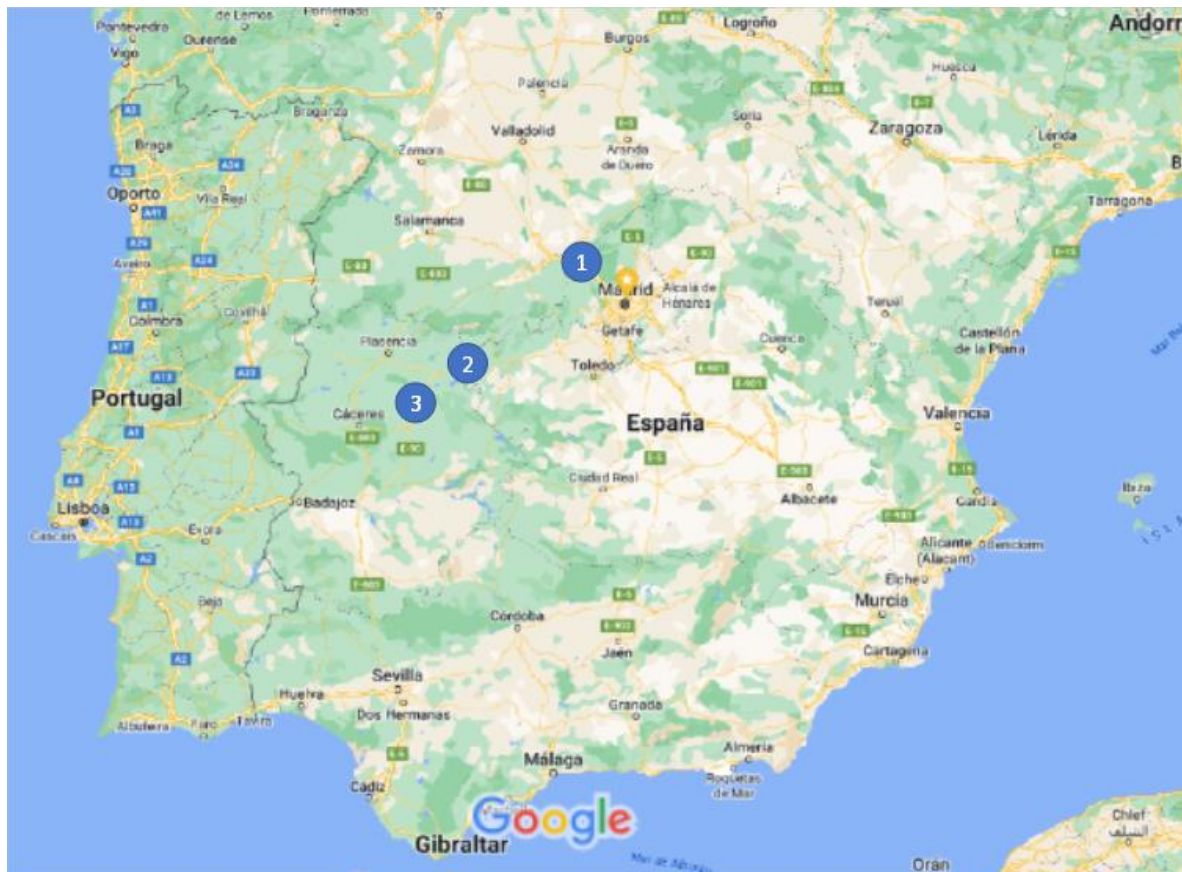
