

PREPARATION FOR AND START OF DECOMMISSIONING

SWEDISH EXPERIENCES (AND OTHERS)

17-19 October, Malmö, Sweden

The Workshop will be organised by WANO Paris Centre in collaboration with Uniper/Sydkraft/Oskarshamn NPP, Sweden.

Objectives

This workshop will focus on the sharing of experiences from the transition into and D&D programmes run by Uniper on their Swedish sites as well as similar experiences from other WANO members. The aim is for the participants to identify key lessons learned and implement actions in line with that in their respective organisations.

Main Topics

Tuesday October 17th - Experiences and lessons learned from transition from generation to D&D

- Testimonies from members of Industry Working Group “Transition to Decommissioning”, including among others: Safety case during transition period, Preparation of waste management facilities and logistics, Organisational transformation.

Wednesday October 18th – The Swedish back-end programme and progress of D&D activities

- National arrangements for waste streams and repositories
- D&D experiences from Oskarshamn units 1&2 and Barsebäck unit 1&2 (including visit and tour of the decommissioning site)

Thursday October 19th – External views and further waste management aspects

- IAEA considerations on transition
- Current situation and experiences from Chernobyl. Experience in decommissioning a nuclear facility after nuclear accidents
- Waste management: Characteristics of radioactive waste (practical use of radionuclide vectors), Effective technologies for decontamination, Reuse of materials, territory and infrastructure for other purposes

Workshop / Seminar language

The workshop / seminar language will be English.
