The Workshop will be organised by WANO Paris Centre

Topics

An analysis of AFI's and events within WANO Paris Centre members have been performed, identifying five main areas of gaps to excellence in the area of Equipment Performance.

The update fleet analysis performed by WANO will be presented and subject to discussions. An overview presentation of the complete analysis will be followed by focused presentations on the sub-topics **Plant configuration and margin management** and **Design Authority**. Break-out sessions (virtual) will be used to allow exchange and sharing of experiences between attendees.

Complementary testimonies from WANO staff and representatives for member NPPs will be given.

Objectives

Based on the first conclusions of the PC fleet analysis, the objectives of the workshop will be to share experience between the Members and to identify the key factors that can leverage an outstanding performance of the engineering structures to fulfil their roles of Technical Authority and Design Authority.

The objective is that each attendee shall take away at least one improvement technique or practice that they will implement at their own site.

Target group

The main target category for attending are engineering managers/leaders on site and corporate level.

Other functions involved in or driving change within engineering are also relevant.

Preparations

To facilitate the exchange of experiences, each attending organisation will be expected to share one success/positive experience and one challenge/weakness.

The on-line event will take place in two separate sessions:

- Wednesday 2 June from 13:00 to 16:00 CET
- Thursday 3 June from 13:00 to 16:00 CET
